Preparation for Piloting Oregon Consortium of Nursing Education (OCNE) competencies and rubrics at Lane Community College

For the last ten months I have served on the statewide committee writing rubrics for the OCNE competencies. During these bi-monthly meetings I learned a great deal of rubric development under the guidance and supervision of PSU faculty and other guest advisors. These rubrics are complete and ready to go to schools to pilot.

Lane Nursing program does not start in OCNE formally until 2007, however faculty have chosen to pilot the format in our existent curriculum. The ending of my assessment project will be to meld:

- □ OCNE rubrics
- OCNE competencies and Lane Core Competencies
