

Please use caution when interpreting data in the two summary Cost-per-FTE reports posted on the Budget Development website: 1) especially for multi-function departments. For example, it is difficult to segregate expenditures for instruction from expenditures for services in a department such as Women's Program, Counseling, or Culinary Arts & Hospitality that is responsible for instructional activities as well other services. Also, 2) when applying the standard methodology for calculating the cost-per-FTE ratio, some departments had a substantial number of their student FTE excluded from the calculations. For some departments, such as the BDC, Continuing Education, the Florence Center, Cooperative Education, applying a manual adjustment to the standard calculation of cost-per-FTE is appropriate to understand more clearly the cost structure of the department. Contact IRAP for more information about these adjustments.

CAVEAT: The methodology this year is **ESSENTIALLY** the same as last year except for in the Art & Applied Dept. See last tab for details.

CAVEAT: The methodology last year was **COMPLETELY** different from the prior two years.

Please review the document called "Cost-per-FTE Change in Methodology.doc" because comparing this year's and last year's results to prior years is not appropriate.

For faculty costs, a very complex subject algorithm was applied to account for the following:

HR \$ with no Subj in Xwalk where instructor did not have any assigned subject taught.

HR \$ with no Subj in Xwalk where instructor had an assigned subject taught.

HR \$ with Subj in Xwalk where instructor did not have any assigned subject taught.

HR \$ with Subj in Xwalk that matched subject taught.

HR \$ with Subj in Xwalk that didn't match subject taught.

Combinations of the above.
