One (1) professional – Past/current employer from the industry **is preferred**, highlighting your work ethic, position(s) held, and duties performed. Please include business letterhead, signature and a phone number they can be reached at.
One (1) personal – Character reference. Can be anyone you would like to use that can speak to your character. Please include signature and a phone number they can be reached at.
 - **Copy of food handlers card** (can be obtained online for \$10)
4. Timely applications to the program are crucial. The program fills up quickly and is based on first applied and qualified, first admitted. Submit the completed application packet by June 30, 2011. Late applications will be accepted if spaces remain available.
