Credit and Community Education Courses

Lane Community College operates on the term or quarter system. Fall, Winter, and Spring terms are each approximately 10 weeks in length followed by a one week period of examinations. Summer term classes are conducted on 4, 8, and 12 week sessions which run simultaneously. Lane Community College also offers Continuing Education courses which are offered on different levels; SD (Skill Development), PD (Professional Development) and EL (Extended Learning). The subject prefix will begin with an "X". The Adult High School program (AH) was discontinued spring of 2003.

Course Numbers:

- Lower division collegiate courses numbered 100-299 are intended as transferable credit classes.
- Prior to summer 2002, Professional/Technical courses used a 4-digit course number. A re-numbering of Professional/Technical courses began summer 2002 using a 100-299 course number and an alpha-subject prefix. Examples are: AM, AB, APPR, AUD, AV, AVN, BT, BVDP, CA, CST, DA, DDA, DH, DRF, DS, ECE, EET, ELT, EMT, FN, FT, GD, HDFS, HIT, HO, HRTM, HS, LAT, LGL, MA, MDP, MFG, MS, MUL, NRG, OA, PGS, RE, RT, VP, WLD, *PTV.
- Prior to summer 2003 all cooperative education courses were numbered FE207 or *FE207. Cooperative Education courses are now numbered with a subject prefix applicable to the subject area and a course number of 180 or 280.
