Learning Plan review and revise Student issues: Intervention Mandatory Orientation Mandatory prerequisites Faculty Office Hour policy Impact of Universal Design and change in focus of Disability Services Filling vacant positions on Learning Council Continued involvement in bond planning Focus on infrastructure needs while planning for the bond Focus on full-time faculty ratio ("people" piece of instruction) Make sure the work of the council has meaning and value Assessment of the governance system Continued effort to promote effective communication within the governance system Stay current with pedagogy and instructional delivery, particularly in online education, with a focus on quality of learning.
