Announcements and reports:	<ul> <li>Discussion:         <ul> <li>Instructional Redesign Taskforce met to discuss two pieces of work identified for further exploration in 2007-2008</li> <li>Two proposed projects that could improve fiscal sustainability, while maintain the quality of student learning and quality of work life.</li> <li>Ongoing research and development</li> <li>The taskforce decided to move the projects to SLI to continue with the implementation.</li> <li>There was no consensus reached on the research and development work.
