It was decided that Tech Council would review all. The first two policies were discussed. The remaining policies will be reviewed at the next meeting.  • Information Technology: Administrative Computer System Baseline Modification <a href="http://www.lanecc.edu/cops/itadmin.htm">http://www.lanecc.edu/cops/itadmin.htm</a> This policy will also be presented at the next BARScg meeting for this committee's input since it addresses the administrative system (Banner) used by several areas of the college.  It was suggested that there is a need for a similar policy for instructional enterprise systems (Moodle) that could encourage innovative use of the product, and more broadly, provide guidelines on how new technology is implemented at Lane. Brad, David and Rob will discuss this idea.  Further discussion led to ideas on how IT can support the needs of the college. The Unit Planning system could be a vehicle for investigating if IT can implement, support or already provides a technology service.
	Grants now cannot be submitted without a line item for IT. This helps ensure that funds are allocated for the IT costs of a project, including

It was noted, however, that Lane should reserve the right to prohibit the insecure use of technology. Students should understand that the computer labs are a public environment and that their privacy in the facility cannot be ensured. There should be a differentiation made between the right of staff to store personal data on a hard drive but not on the network.</li> </ul>
