




Native American Longhouse

Yet Lane has annually served more than 660 self-identified Native American students, more than at any other United States community college. Lane has collaborated with tribal officials to develop an outstanding academic program, host an annual powwow, and offer support services such as the Native American Student Program. The Longhouse is the next step to add to this success. It will also be the first traditional Longhouse on a community college campus in the U.S.
