Respiratory Care just had an outstanding programmatic accreditation site visit by CoARC. Based on the excellent visit, no further action will be taken for another 10 years!

Successful Aging Institute:

In anticipation of the Downtown Campus moving across the street from the Eugene Public Library, Lane's Successful Aging Institute and the library are collaborating to present an ongoing series of free classes for adults of all ages at EPL. SAI will produce the classes, EPL will pay the instructors, and both will publicize them. Five classes have been scheduled thus far, starting in May.
