#### - Lower division transfer

We offer a comprehensive transfer program that articulates with the AAOT to prepare students to enter their major at the junior level. We have initiated an articulated 2+2 program with NCC. Our Music Tech students transfer to the UofO, NCC, WOSU, Burklee College of Music in Boston and others.

#### - Lifelong personal development and enrichment

Nearly all music classes serve this need-many students later become music majors.

#### - Cultural and community service

Our students perform and engineer in nearly all local venues.

The Music Discipline has prioritized the growth and development of its Music Technology curriculum within the existing music offerings. To this end, we have completed the addition of appropriate facilities and equipment for courses in this area, which serves our students well. In addition to providing appropriate technical resources to all of our music students, this improvement allows for in-depth music technology experiences that are in continual demand by the students.

Music production, composition, arranging, sound design, ear training, theory skills, history, performance, and notation are practical elements that are greatly enhanced by the use of technology. Our students benefit from the services provided to them in the Music Technology Lab—a room with 20 MIDI/Audio workstations. This requested initiative will increase the technical advantages available to our students, by keeping our technology current.

As the hardware and software is updated during the next year, the effectiveness and efficiency of the learning process will be enhanced.

Both students and staff benefit from the technology we provide.

We are committed to providing appropriate technical training to students in the area of music.
