ALS/Tutor 2008-09 Initiative: Align SKD030 (Using Computers to Write 1) with WR80

Summary:

The current curriculum for Using Computers to Write 1 is too difficult for a first computer writing course for developmental students. This project proposes revising UCW1 so it aligns with WR080.

Description:

This proposal would align Using Computers to Write 1 with WR080 so the two could be used as companion classes and taken simultaneously to reinforce learning or used as a 3-credit stand-alone class after a student takes WR80 or before a student takes WR090.

With only seven contract faculty, two with release time working on other college functions, aligning SKD030 with WR080 will help contract and part-time faculty maintain consistency in delivery. One faculty position has been vacant for 1 year and is not on the list to be replaced for 2008-09 a 12.5% reduction in contract staff.

• If the course is taught in the CEN 232 lab it is limited to 16 students per class.

• Offering two sections per term for three terms would allow 96 students to be served.
