CFE 2008-09 Initiative: Two Smart Carts for ECE Classes

Summary:

To use Technology funds to purchase the software and equipment for two Smart Carts to be used for Early Childhood Education instructional classes. One Smart Cart will be stationed on the main campus in Building #4 where most ECE classes are currently scheduled. The second Smart Cart will be stationed in the Child and Family Education Village, to be used in classrooms there.

Description:

With the development of the new Child and Family Education Department and the merge of different programs within it, ECE faculty have lost access to all the resources and equipment that were previously available through the Family and Health Careers Division. These faculty members are now located in the Child and Family Education Village, and are teaching the ECE courses in different areas of campus than before. The CFE department has no additional resources to purchase the necessary equipment needed to address different learning styles, which the Smart Cart will facilitate. So, we are requesting two Smart Carts to be located in the two main areas where the ECE courses are being taught: Building 4 and the Child and Family Education Village.
