# **Coop Ed 2008-09 Initiative: Expanding Apprenticeship Opportunities for Students**

## Summary:

Current non-credit courses in apprenticeship must be converted to credit by Fall of 2009 in order to offer the Statewide degree program. New Pathways programs are being developed where Lane could increase programs in roofing and heavy equipment operation.

## **Description:**

More efficient use of regular full-time faculty (capacity utilization). Added value to students through creation of degree pathway.

Enrollment increase due to offering on-line instruction serves more students statewide for a relatively low cost.

Create a new roofing training program, one course per term. Potential to increase programs offered by Apprenticeship with associated increase in enrollment in non-credit classes.

1. Apprenticeship has been an under-funded program since its reorganization in 2000. One Program Coordinator is the only general funded position associated with operation of this program. The position we are requesting funding for is absolutely critical in continuing this important connection to the business community. In addition this position has been key in offering new on-line, state-wide instruction in Limited Energy for over 70 students. We have continually requested more support for the Apprenticeship Program through our initiatives.

A .49 FTE timesheet employee to support students in the Apprenticeship Program. Cost is \$15,805.69 + \$5,452.96 OPE. We are requesting these funds from the Perkins grant.

The total general fund budget for Apprenticeship is approximately \$200,000. Normally the FTE for the program has been in the 180 - 250 range making it extremely low cost. It all goes toward the operation of the program. The conversion to credit is an additional burden to an already efficient operation.
