Enroll Svcs 2008-09 Initiative: Hands-on Careers Exploration Day

Summary:

Hands-on Careers Exploration Day supports the college's efforts to increase enrollment with innovative recruitment strategies by bringing over 350 local high students to campus to explore our Career and Technical Programs.

Description:

Hands-On Careers Exploration Day is a half-day workshop that allows Lane county high school students to come on campus and do a hands-on learning activity in a career area of their choice. Current Lane students serve as mentors and facilitators during the day. The purpose is to expose high school students to technical careers and to motivate them to pursue higher education. It has been an annual event for three years and there is an extremely high interest on the part of the college and the high schools to continue it.

Students are assigned to different classes and have a chance to test out different Career and Technical Programs. Lane arranges for transportion by bus, provides lunches for the attendees, pays for the publicity for the event and rents out multiple rooms in the Center for Meeting and Learning. Next to Lane Preview Night, it is the biggest on-campus event sponsored by Enrollment Services throughout the year.
