

Health Professions 2008-09 Initiative: Modification of HO 100 Introduction to Health Occupations for PTA Program

Summary:

HO 100 Introduction to Health Occupations is currently offered for any student in the College to explore health occupations. The Physical Therapist Assistant Program currently being developed at Lane requires that PTA students take an Intro to Health Occ course. Adapting the Intro to Health Occ course we currently offer would make it possible to PTA students to take the currently-offered course and simultaneously allow all students to enroll.

Description:

HO 100 is a 2 credit hour course which offers an overview of a wide variety of health occupations to be explored by the learner. With a modification that would require 40 hours of curriculum development, this course could be adapted to include information salient to the PTA program and meet their requirement.
