Library 2008-09 Initiative: Improve accessibility and currency of library resources

Summary:

To continue support for library online resources, improve search functionality of these resources, and enhance resources for special Lane populations

Description:

- Improve accessibility and currency of library resources for all Lane students
 - Create and embed access to library assistance and resources in online course offerings; e. g. widgets, course guides, Ask-a-Librarian options, etc.
 - Maintain currency and accessibility of online reference sources and general periodical databases
 - Continue inclusion of library online periodicals in library catalog to enhance access
 - Subscribe to federated search engine, such as WebFeat or LibraryFind, to allow simultaneous searching of multiple databases
- Improve accessibility and currency of library resources for Career and Technical Education students
 - Expand and continue collection of specialized online reference sources such as Safari Tech Books Online, ProQuest's Career and Technical Education College Collection, Automotive Reference Center, CINAHL, Nursing Journals and data sheets, etc.
- Purchase collection of CTE textbooks for Reserve/In-Library-Use only
 - Develop CTE-focused library brochure
 - Develop print and non-print collection of materials to support new College programs such as Water Conservation, GIS, Physical Therapy, Sustainability, Peace
- Participate in development of Learning Commons initiative for November 2008 bond measure.

- As identified in the self-study and subsequent site visit, the budget for Library resources is inadequate to the population we serve. And what resources are available must be accessible to students any time, anywhere. It remains an ongoing objective to make the best use of the library's budget, and to optimize access to library resources.

 - By ongoing improvement in selection of, access to, and effective use of, library resources.
 - By expansion of library resources to target Career and Technical Education students
 - Learning Commons would increase efficiency of library space and allow greater access to library materials
- Continuation of plan started last year?
 - Some parts of this initiative are continuations of funding begun in years past. Examples:
 - Fiscal support for library online periodical databases and online reference collections
 - Inclusion of library online periodicals in library catalog
 - Request for funding of federated search engine was approved several years ago; we did not move forward on this item as the search engines at that time were deemed too undeveloped. There has been considerable improvement in functionality since that time, and the ability to search multiple databases simultaneously would have enormous appeal to Lane students
