LLC 2008-09 Initiative: Audio-Visual Technology Upgrades for Speech and Communications

Summary:

According to Dennis Mills and Michael Levick, Lane will no longer support audiotaping and videotaping in technology purchases and upgrades. Since the Speech and Communication Studies department has relied exclusively on these means to record student performance, we need to investigate the facility and affordability, leading to purchase, of substitute technologies for faculty and students in both live and online formats, particularly for those classes which do not meet in smart classrooms.

Description:

 Assess/locate potential portable technologies that can provide alternate recording capabilities for students in audio settings, allowing them to record their voices in a small group setting in class and to retain for analysis their portion of the recording session.
Assess/locate potential portable technologies that can provide alternative recording capabilities for students in classroom video sessions, allowing individual possession, recording and playback capabilities.

3. Purchase equipment that will provide capabilities described above.
