The department improved Core College Connections reading and writing curriculum to meet the needs of under-prepared students who tested below 56 on the college placement tests

40 students enrolled in the class fall term 2007, and 32 completed. Student retook the college placement test and the average point gain on the Accuplacer Reading test was 21 points.
