In partnership with Lane ESD, work sessions were held in three career technical fields: Early Childhood Education, Drafting, and Health Occupations. (Nursing, Medical Office Assistant, and Health Records Technology). High school teachers, representing Lane County's 22 high schools, and Lane faculty and staff met to better align the high school programs with Lane's career technical programs.
