The department pilot tested the first term of the *OPABS Bridge Math Course*.

The course was benchmarked to postsecondary level courses, uses systematic lesson plans, skills framework, strategy instruction, and integrates occupational information with basic skills. The second term course was developed and will be pilot tested fall term 2009.
