BUILDING AND CLASSROOM DEVELOPMENT:

Redesign and renovate buildings 10 and 11 to accommodate fine arts studios and classrooms to alleviate crowded conditions in building 11 and facilitate expansion of existing and development of new programs and classes in the arts and integrative arts. Replace outdated and worn seats in the performing arts hall and install an elevator to provide access in building 6 for the Music, Dance and Theatre Programs.

Redesign and renovate building 17 first and second floors to accommodate expansion and development of the Media Arts program and to better integrate programs in Media Arts, Graphic Design and Student Publications to reflect the real world model.

Redesign parts of building 5 to add a second dance studio to accommodate the rapid expansion of the dance program.

Redesign and renovate Room 149 of building 6 to create a more diverse use of classroom space and expand essential keyboard classes in Music.

Submitted and received approval to renovate and occupy the second floor of building 17 to integrate Media Arts faculty offices within the same building that serves the program and to provide a new open media lab for program students. The work should be completed Fall term.
