HIGH SCHOOL OUTREACH

Through the ArtsWorks in Education initiative, the Lane Arts Division supported the training of more than 300 high school teachers, administrators and artists to integrate arts learning process into core academic subject areas in ten public schools in Oregon, primarily in Lane County. This program served more then 2,000 students in 70 elementary, middle school and high school math, science, language, and social science classrooms during the 2007-2008 academic year.

Significantly expanded College Now offerings to include 25 class articulations in 8 high schools to earn 412 credits and 17 fte.
