Automotive Technology:

The curriculum delivery was changed to deliver all 8 courses in the curriculum each term. This was implemented by using small group instruction linked with computer based training and dedicated lab areas and projects. Enrollment capacity was increased and student learning enhanced.

Fast Track Automotive was implemented and the first cohort began. This partnership between the community businesses, students and the automotive program is successful. This course will be continued for 08/09 school year.
