Drafting:

The Drafting Program was awarded curriculum development funds for a Landscape Technology mini certificate. This program ran successfully in both spring and summer terms.

The Drafting program was able to renew 30 AutoCAD licenses and upgrade to the AutoCAD 2009. This installation occurred in Drafting Lab 206 and 208. This program upgrade gave the students the latest technology to enhance their learning experience and increase employability skills. The Technology Fee allocated \$12,000 to fund this project.
