

## Video Material Development:

Both Business and CIT are developing and using video materials as part of online, hybrid and traditional course offerings. Courses have been professionally videotaped and produced with support from Distance Learning; course lecture material is routinely videotaped using a video cart; rooms 19/126 is in the process of being converted into a smart classroom with video/audio capture capabilities, and the Division lead in development of infrastructure to create similar capacity for 19/130, 2/209 and 2/203.
