### **Increase Utilization**

The David Joyce Gallery continues to exhibit two art shows during the year. Local photographers including LCC faculty members and local artist Mike Van were featured in 2007-08. The exhibit entitled Chefs and Bakers Revisited sold a record of \$2310. Additional art purchases were made to enhance the CML collection.

New additions: Integration of ITunes enhances the wireless connection for the Center for Meeting and Learning; Installation of an outside reader board creates a state-of-the-art welcoming for CML events; and Implementation of EventPro, leading to streamlining of processes to include: event detail inputting, proposal generation, cost estimates for clients, invoicing and receipting. EventPro also serves as a more proficient program for tracking clientele and revenues.

An aethetics committee was created in the efforts in boosting our inventory of presentable decor with different themes and seasonal decoration ideas for buffets. The committee made needed organizational improvements in the loading dock where decorations are stored.
