## **CNA Lab at Downtown Center**

### **Summary:**

Setup a lab to use for CNA classes.

### **Description**

Due to increased demand for CNA classes and the constraints on the existing lab available on Main Campus we are converting the room currently used for the Phelbotomy class to also serve the CNA classes as the lab. This involves mostly 'furniture' with very little strutural modifications.
