

Infrastructure Development:

New laptops were purchased for 19/126 as a result of Perkins funding, enabling increased capacity for computer courses taught in this room. Many server developments were made, including the use of virtual server technology.

Computer replacements were made for several CIT faculty who received new laptop computers, and Business faculty as a group received new office computers, many of whom also got an additional large-format monitor to support intensive computer application development and instructional work. New hardware was researched and purchased to support the Network Security curriculum.

Technologies that are new to the Division were developed, notably the use of web conferencing (Adobe Connect) to support online office hours and tutorial instruction, and the use of dept wikis for dept administration and student and community outreach.
