Approximately 200 high school students from throughout Lane County will come to the Hands-on Career Day at Lane to be introduced to Career/technical programs at Lane through experiential workshops with Lane faculty. Students pre-register for this event which allows for an exact count as well as the ability to track which high schools the students are associated with.
