Part Time Faculty Backfill for Electronic/Apprenticeship Program Courses

Summary:

This initiative requests three terms of .336 part-time faculty to back fill electronic technology courses no longer taught by the designated Apprenticeship Faculty Lead. The Apprenticeship Lead Faculty is needed to meet accreditation requirements per Northwest Accreditation standards.

Description

Apprenticeship is undergoing a conversion from non-credit to credit. According to Northwest Accreditation standards, all AAS degree programs must have a lead faculty assigned to oversee program and curriculum development. This initiative requests three terms of .336 part-time faculty to back fill electronic technology courses no longer taught by the designated Apprenticeship Faculty Lead.
