Integration of MPEG4 encoder giving MPEG4 capture (web content).

Full completion room Building 19, room 255 with improved IP videoconference capability, satellite teleconferencing, audioconferencing, and ability to originate and receive webinars (Adobe Connect).

Three Brightline fluorescent studio lights were purchased and installed in the tv studio to replace incandescent light fixtures. Benefits include reduced electrical consumption and lengthened life of lamps. Sustainable option for studio lighting.
