Replaced aging field production camera with Sony 1080i HDV format camera. Also replaced minidisk format audio recorder with flash memory audio recorder. Ease of use and compatibility of format allows instructors to upload course lectures to course websites.

Constructed lecture capture cart for in-classroom use to allow instructors to capture video and audio on to DVD. Recorded materials are used to build web content for online and hybrid classes.

Constructed a portable IP videoconferencing cart to support classes and meetings in rooms not equipped with videoconferencing equipment. The portable IP cart allows scheduling flexibility when existing IP facilities are otherwise in use.
