# **Initiative Report for IT 2009-10**

# **Distance Learning IP Video Equipment Replacement**

## **Summary:**

We are requesting funding to replace three IP video units in the Distance Learning facility. The equipment is used to provide interactive courses (two-way video and audio), meetings and training to remote sites.

# **Description**

The IP video equipment serving the studio classroom (19/257) and conference room #1 (19/254) will be at end-of-life December 2009, and conference room #2 (19/255) IP equipment will be at end-of-life December 2010.

After December 2009 (and 2010, respectively), the equipment will no longer be supported by the manufacturers. Maintenance contracts, and most likely parts, repair, and software updates, will not be available. Current maintenance contracts expire September 2009 for 19/257 and 19/254, and in April 2009 for 19/255.

Most of the equipment in the DL facility was purchased with bond funds and is aging. Distance Learning has been able to absorb the cost of replacing and repairing smaller, less expensive equipment, but DL's budget is not funded for equipment replacement. This request is being issued in an effort to document the need for replacement of this equipment over the next few years, and to establish a replacement plan for the future.

#### Describe the resources needed:

We are requesting \$30,000 to purchase three new IP video units. (These units are sold in packages which include the hardware, software and maintenance) While it may not be essential to replace all three units at one time, it is our recommendation to replace the unit in the studio classroom (19/257) immediately (as a minimum) and then begin a replacement schedule. IP equipment at Cottage Grove and Florence is not included in the DL inventory and replacement, when needed, would be addressed separately.

Hardware (CH) \$30,000

What specific measurable program outcomes do you expect to achieve with this initiative? The outcomes should be specific enough to be measurable. Also, outline the method that will be used to determine the results.

During 08-09, 27 courses are being sent over IP video to remote locations. Most classes are required courses in the Health Records Technology program, plus 5 social science courses, American Indian Language (100 & 200 level) courses, and one course in the Dental Hygiene program. Of the 27 courses, 21 are sent from the studio classroom. Without reliable, serviceable equipment, we may not be able to continue offering IP video courses to Cottage Grove, Florence, and our partner schools. Delivery of scheduled courses may not be completed and students may not be able to finish individual courses or possibly degree or certificate programs. IP equipment is also used to enable staff to attend meetings and training reducing travel time and costs to the college.

Some department general funds could be allocated to this purchase. It would not be possible for the department to absorb the entire cost. Also, technical staff time would be required to remove the old equipment and install and test the new equipment.
