Worked with regional high schools to offer College Now courses, resulting in a total of 263.61 FTE in 2007-08. CN-generated FTE increased across 3 of the 4 departments from 2006-07: English FTE increased by 55.2% (from 26.9 FTE to 60.2), French by 59.2% (from 21.3 FTE to 59.2) and Spanish by 56.8% (from 54.7 FTE to 126.5).
