

Initiative Report for Library 2009-10

Maintain currency of and expand information resources for students

Summary:

To continue support for library online resources, improve search functionality of these resources, and enhance resources for special Lane populations

Description

Maintain and enhance access to online instructional support resources such as:

- Online reference sources and general periodical databases
- specific resources for Career and Technical Education students, such as Automotive Reference Center, CINAHL, Nursing Journals and Nursing Reference Center, Computer simulation and game development, Construction Technology, Culinary Arts and Food Service Management, Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting, Adult Development and Aging, etc.
- Develop print and audiovisual collection of materials to support new College programs and Career Technical courses, such as Water Conservation, GIS, Physical Therapy, CNA2, and Pharmacy Technician

As noted in the data elements of this and prior unit plan years, the budget for Library resources is inadequate to the population we serve. And what resources are available must be accessible to students any time, anywhere. It remains an ongoing objective to make the best use of the library budget, and to optimize access to library resources.

Continuing and expanding online information resources for students is a major library goal.

This initiative continues the achievement of these goals by:

- ongoing improvement in selection of, access to, and effective use of, library resources, and
- expansion of library resources to target Career and Technical Education students

This initiative is a continuation of funding begun in years past. These are:

- Fiscal support for general library online periodical databases and online reference collections
- Fiscal support for the development and maintenance of library resources to support Career Technical programs

The provision of online aggregated databases is an extremely efficient and effective way to give access to a wealth of information with a minimum of staff effort.
