Our Developmental Algebra Initiative (from the 2007/08 unit planning process) to revise the developmental algebra curriculum was funded. In Spring 2008, a combined textbook was adopted for MTH 060, 065, 070, and 095 to allow for better articulation between courses and for cost savings to students. Lead instructors for the courses are coordinating the modification of curriculum, activities, assignments, and the use of an online instructional support tool called MathXL. They are also working to include problems that address the needs of nursing program students for whom MTH 095 is now a requirement. Funding from this initiative is also being utilized for adapting MTH 052: Math for Introductory Physical Science to a new text that supports traditional and online instruction and meets the needs of the Medical Office Assistant program for which MTH 052 is now a requirement.
