#### Summary:

Summary: Determine role of online and hybrid classes in ALS and create implementation plan. Fund curriculum development to offer online and/or hybrid sections of EL115: Effective Learning.

#### Description

Develop curriculum to offer online and/or hybrid sections of EL115:Effective Learning. Form a faculty committee to review ALS course offerings and determine prioritization for hybrid and online sections of other courses. Develop a process for faculty members to offer hybrid and online sections. Write initiatives annually for curriculum development funding to convert some sections of other courses to online and/or hybrid format.

The purposes of this initiative are to:

In 2010-2011, ALS offered 8 sections of Math 10 in a hybrid format and 2 sections in an online format, which was an initiative last year. The purpose of this initiative is to continue this achievement by increasing and/or initiating hybrid/online offerings for other ALS courses.

1. This curriculum development work meets the department goal of increasing online/hybrid offerings for improved access for students and to maximize use of classroom space..
2. This work will significantly increase the use of technology by ALS faculty and will integrate technology in instruction.
3. This work will introduce learners to online/hybrid formats to expand their options and success in future coursework.

EL115: Effective Learning

This curriculum development project is extremely valuable to other faculty members. EL115 has been one of the core courses offered by ALS. The curriculum developed will serve as a model for other instructors of EL115 as well as a model for online/hybrid options for other ALS courses.

In 2009-10, 799 students registered for the 3-credit Effective Learning class. ALS offered 26 sections of Effective Learning, 1 section of EL115E (for non-native English speakers), 2 sections of EL115H and 2 sections of EL115T (Women in Transition). In addition, 2 sections are offered in Cottage Grove and those numbers are not included in ALS FTE. A lack of classroom space impacts the number of sections that can be offered. Hybrid and online sections would reduce classroom hours while increasing access for students who can't come to campus three hours per week at the times classes are offered.

If one online/hybrid section could be offered per term and curriculum development for this course will impact a minimum of 132 students per year .

EL115: Effective Learning

Students will have more options for enrolling in EL115. Some students prefer the format of hybrid/online courses, and some students can only enroll in hybrid/online courses for a variety of reasons. These students have not been served by ALS and will be as a result of this project.

By offering hybrid/online sections of EL115, ALS will meet a broader range of students learning styles. One section of EL115 is specifically designed and tailored to meet the needs of non-native English speakers and international students.
