BUS Convert Existing Tutoring Videos to Online Format

Summary:

Curriculum development funding for faculty to convert the existing tutoring videos to a format that enables them to be available for viewing online.

Description

Requesting 200 hours of curriculum development to make the existing tutoring videos that have been developed by faculty over the past few years available online.

The Business Department has developed many video tutorials for use by our online students. They are available to students when they are enrolled in a class through Moodle. The department would like these resources to be available for students all of the time by publishing them to YouTube. To accomplish this, all of the existing tutorials must be re-rendered in a different video format. We believe these resources will help students as they progress through our programs by making refresher resources available to them on an as needed basis.

Goals: Student Success & Retention

1. Over the past few years, the Business Department has been engaged in a range of focused efforts to improve student support and retention: developing the Student Resource Center (2-107), curriculum updates across all programs, increased tutoring support including the use of Learn & Earn student peer tutors/mentors, and development of online resources.

Efficiencies: Shared Instructional Resources

1. The Business Department faculty continued development of online video resources, including both the creation of instructional videos and tutorial screen capture webcasts, particularly in the

Accounting program. We now have 10-20 minute videos to explain almost all the accounting and excel concepts that students typically struggle with. These videos are not course or textbook-specific, so can be used in any class that works with a particular topic, from introductory to high-level.
