Accomplishment Description:

Financial Stability

The Center for Meeting and Learning, a fully self-funded department, came in just under the 2007-08 revenue of \$902,862 by bringing in a total of \$897,573 YTD in 2008-09 with a less than 1% decrease. This accomplishment secures its General Fund relief of \$47,900 to support the salary (.5 FTE) of a culinary arts faculty in 2009-10. See Foodservices accomplishments for additional General Fund relief. The number of guests served in 2008-09 was 117,616 with external events amassing 85% of the revenue.
