Food Services 2008-09

Accomplishment Description:

Financial Stability

This Accomplishment addresses the previously mentioned Accomplishment on Financial Stability. Campus Food Service, a self-funded department, generated a final total of \$1,900,237.49 in revenue during the 2008-09 fiscal year. This total includes the following revenue-generating services: Food Sales, Dining Cards, Non-Instructional Sales, Oak Hill School, Lane Child Care/Misc. Revenue, and Vending. This secures its General Fund relief of \$47,900 to support the salary (.5 FTE) of a culinary arts faculty member in 2009-10. Campus Food Service served 457,373 customers, and sales continue to increase with the increase of higher enrollment and campus visitors.
