Update Smart Classroom Equipment

Summary:

The existing equipment in two smart classrooms and on a portable cart were installed from a generation of equipment that is no longer used or perhaps serviceable. This initiative seeks replacement.

Description

An update to this equipment would enhance the classrooms without the added expense of having to install an infrastructure. Technology needs do not need expansion at the Cottage Grove campus, but it is becoming apparent that the existing equipment will need increased servicing. The equipment dates to the time the building first opened, approximately 11 years ago. Replacement would be a prudent step toward enhancing the equipment and reducing service costs.
