New Co-op Scholarships for Nursing Students

Jean Harclerod, Nursing Cooperative Education Coordinator, established cooperative education scholarships for nursing students with need for financial assistance through McKenzie Willamette Hospital and the Oregon Nurses Association. Tuition for co-op credits was fully funded by one or the other of these two organizations. In this, the first year, five students received scholarships.
