Accomplishment Description:

New Occupational and Employment Skills Training Programs

Employment Skills Training evolved into one of the entry points for Career Pathways effort. Different college departments have created mini certificates as part of their Career Pathways with has eliminated the need for EST as a stand alone program. Expanded cooperative education opportunities for Continuing Education students in new skill areas including Medical Receptionist, Music Thanatology, Pharmacy Technician, and Veterinary Technician. Increased FTE by 26 percent across all Occupational program areas with associated increases in enrollment and collection of tuition and fees.
