Curriculum development in Nutrition

Summary:

Curriculum development for FN 206,280, MY Lane portal and advanced skill training

Description

For FN 206 and FN 280, we would like CD funds to develop these new classes (Nutrition Services and Medical Nutrition Therapy) for our dietary manager new concentration in Culinary. In addition, we would like to request an additional 70 hours to be split between our faculty for additional training in online education (specific web based tools that can be used in all Nutrition courses). Furthermore, in order to make Nutrition a better presence on campus at LCC, we would like 100 hours of CD to put together short information bites that can be put on the New MY LANE portal to enhance community knowledge of Nutrition....

Although going ahead with the Dietary Manager curriculum is a continuation of last years goals, bringing classes online is a consistent emphasis at LCC and learning more tools for increased technology savvy is important. Furthermore, the new portal (MYLANE) is new and we have been asked to be a regular feature. Since we have no 1.0 fte faculty (we have faculty..one at .53 and one at .63) and teach hundreds of FTEs in Nutrition, this would be an excellent opportunity for our part time faculty to be more involved.

Describe the resources needed:

We would need cd funding for 350 hours. $350 \times 29.15 = \$8745 + 2807 \text{ ope} = 11,552.00$
