

# **Information Technology 2008-09**

## **Accomplishment Description:**

Overall Distance Learning enrollment, FTE and number of sections grew by 33 percent over the previous year. Online course statistics grew the most dramatically with a 35 percent increase in enrollment and FTE and a 42 percent increase in the number of sections. There were 129 different online courses offered, including 39 new courses never having been offered before in the online format. Telecourses also experienced increases in enrollment (26%) and FTE (18%). Live interactive courses offered over cable television and IP video increased 41 percent in enrollment and 45 percent in FTE.
