# Language, Literature & Communication 2008-09

### **Accomplishment Description:**

The LLC Division increased its capacity, especially in writing classes, to respond to the surge in overall college enrollment (approx 15%) by hiring 8 additional part-time instructors using the college's new online hiring process. Student FTE increased from 952.7 in 07-08 to 1,082 in 08-09, an increase of 13.6%; Total number of section increased from 485 to 515, an increase of 6.2%.
