Human Services Equipment in Videotaping Room

Summary:

Purchase and install a digital recording system so students can consistently and successfully record their counseling sessions. The current equipment is very old and breaks down.

Description

The Human Service program prepares students to work in the community in a variety of settings. Skills in interviewing and counseling are essential to this profession. One of the ways that students develop these skills is to record an interview/counseling session with a classmate. The student, faculty, and classmates can then review this recorded session. As a result of this process, students receive feedback that allows them to identify specific skills to work on during the term. Our current video recording equipment is very old and complicated. Frequently it does not work or students fail to follow the complicated instructions. When students spend time in recording a DVD only to learn that it didn't record, they become quite frustrated. Additionally, with over 60 students using the equipment over the term, and students, busy schedules, it is often very difficult to reschedule another time.

This initiative is not directly linked to last year's request but is similar in that this request seeks to improve the quality of students' educational experience and skill development. Students enroll in a number of counseling skills classes and are required to record and review their skills. Feedback from faculty and other students, as well their own self-evaluation, is essential for students' professional growth.

Describe the resources needed:

We would like to replace our older equipment with newer equipment. We have good cameras installed in the room. However, the rest of the system consists of two 20 plus years old, 8 inch monitors, a sound board, an old broken VHS recorder through which the sound get recorded and passed on to a DVD recorder. The DVD then must be finalized through directions on the monitor and this takes an additional 15 minutes. Frequently this step doesn't work. By purchasing an IMAC computer and a video capture card, students could record directly onto the computer and put their session on a thumb drive or burn a DVD or even put it on the Internet. They could send the file home to themselves or to another classmate for feedback. The equipment required to upgrade the system includes:

Students develop these skills by observing, practicing, and then getting feedback on their performance of specific skills. Being able to record and then watch themselves as well as other students is essential to this process.

How will funding this initiative increase or sustain the number of CTE students that graduate or receive a one year certificate from Lane and help prepare the students for employment?

Currently, approximately 60 students per term will utilize the recording equipment. Recording and analyzing students' interviewing and counseling skills is the traditional approach to training students and preparing them for their roles as human service workers.
