Implementation of Learning Standards

Summary:

The ABSE department will update its curriculum plan incorporating learning standards.

Description

The OCCWD has implemented a five year plan to incorporate state learning standards for the ABS system in Oregon. Lane was involved in the development of the standards, has representatives on the steering committee, and has four state trainers from ABSE and ESL.

The standards are an articulation of key sets of knowledge and skills which are transferable to post-secondary education/training, employment and other outcomes. The framework provides a clearly -delineated continuum of skill development that guides goal- setting, curriculum, instruction, assessment, and accountability. The framework aligns with formal and informal assessment and provides for consistency across programs.

The department has several people attending training and becoming trainers for the state.

The department received a Learning Standards Implementation grant to support release time for trainers and to send faculty and staff to general learning standards orientations.

This is a five year implementation for learning standards. The outcomes will be improved alignment between levels and programs, improved alignment at transition levels, improved curriculum, and improved instruction.
