Accomplishment Description:

Academic Learning Skills and English as a Second Language departments worked together to change RD93/WR93 and RD89/WR89 course delivery from non-credit/credit format to "credit only" to increase fiscal sustainability. Non-credit/credit required too much staff time to manage and process was confusing to students and staff. Unfortunately, some students who need the class cannot afford the credit costs, although a developing ESL scholarship may help. The credit model is meeting the needs of a growing number of international students.
