Summary:

Position the LCC SBDC, the Employee Training Department, and eDev as the first stop (and only stop needed) for Lane County organizations seeking assistance, or in the need of additional resources.

Description

Our goal is to use our physical presence at the SBDC to give personalized assistance and referrals to other resources when business owners and leaders from around Lane County walk in the door, call, or email. In addition, we want to provide an online directory of resources and contacts for people who may need assistance at any hour and any day of the week. Members of the Eugene Chamber's Economic Development Council had the following thoughts regarding a Business "First Stop and One Stop":

- Current and comprehensive list of resources,
- Smooth and seamless process for entrepreneurs,
- Countywide coverage, accessible 24 x 7 with virtual/online,
- High level of customer service and followup,
- Greater collaboration between Lane County resources,
- Memorable name, contact info, and marketing,
- No "Red Tape",
